SUPERVISES: None

SPECIFIC DUTIES

- Works in program areas during the day as assigned.
- Assists with meal preparation and kitchen cleanup as assigned.
- Assists with service tasks as assigned.
- Serves as a liaison to one or two families, as assigned, as follows:
 - Eats occasional meals with the family.
 - Offers to build, and/or light, fires in their fireplace, if they live in a camper cabin.
 - Assists the family with their service task if not assigned elsewhere.
 - Brings the concerns of the family to the Family Camp Director.
- Assists with all evening programs as an enthusiastic participant.

ADDITIONAL DUTIES

- Maintains the cleanliness of the living space to which he or she is assigned.
- Models, teaches, and upholds the Camp Echo Code of Conduct and protects the well-being of all participants.
- Cares for and maintains equipment, supplies and property of camp.
- Maintains positive relationships with children, parents and other staff.
- Encourages physical, emotional and spiritual growth and positive character development in all campers
- Works to increase his or her own cultural competence and helps to create an environment that values diversity
- Prepared to do anything else deemed necessary by the Camp Director.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Finished 3 or 4 years of high school -- age 16 or older -- under 18 and still in HS requires Michigan "work permit"
- Certified in CPR, First Aid and preferably Lifeguard
- Possess a variety of skills and camping experience
- A commitment to working with a diverse staff and camper population for the fulfillment of YMCA goals
